

OPS DISPENSERS Installation Guide

- 1. Find the Stud when possible and center 1 row of the dispenser center holes so the fastener goes into the stud. If there are 2 center rows, just choose the one that will look best.
- 2. Use the dispenser's back as your template lining up the center holes to the stud and marking the place where the anchors will be placed.
- 3. Use an anchor suggested by your maintenance department and the size drill bit that that anchor requires.
- 4. Mark the center holes and the 4 holes on each corner of the dispenser. **Important**: Always use the top 2 holes and the bottom 2 holes to anchor the dispenser.
- 5. Center holes should be used even if there is no available stud.
- 6. Drill the holes you marked on the wall according to the instructions of the Anchors you have chosen.
- 7. Place the anchors in the wall and hammer until flush.
- 8. Place the dispenser against the wall and line it up to the anchor holes.
- 9. Screw all the fasteners into the wall, not tightening any screw down all the way until you check double check that the dispenser is level.
- 10. Tighten all the screws into the fasteners.
